A COACH'S CODE OF CONDUCT

The head coach is always responsible for his/her assistants, parents, family, guest, team members, and equipment.

Any coaching staff member found in violation of the following codes may be suspended or removed from their position.

- 1. Always use good sportsmanship including a positive attitude.
- 2. No foul or abusive language, including cheers.
- 3. Never attend a team function under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs. Any clothing or apparel with an EGSL logo may never be worn while consuming alcohol.
- 4. Be on time for practices and games. This includes from the time the event is scheduled to start until the last girl is picked up.
- 5. Any team function requires a woman 18 or older to be present. This includes from the time the event is scheduled to start until the last girl is picked up.
- 6. Never use lack of moral character.
