- Selling/distributing any flyers or goods not approved by Uihlein Soccer Park Management is strictly prohibited.

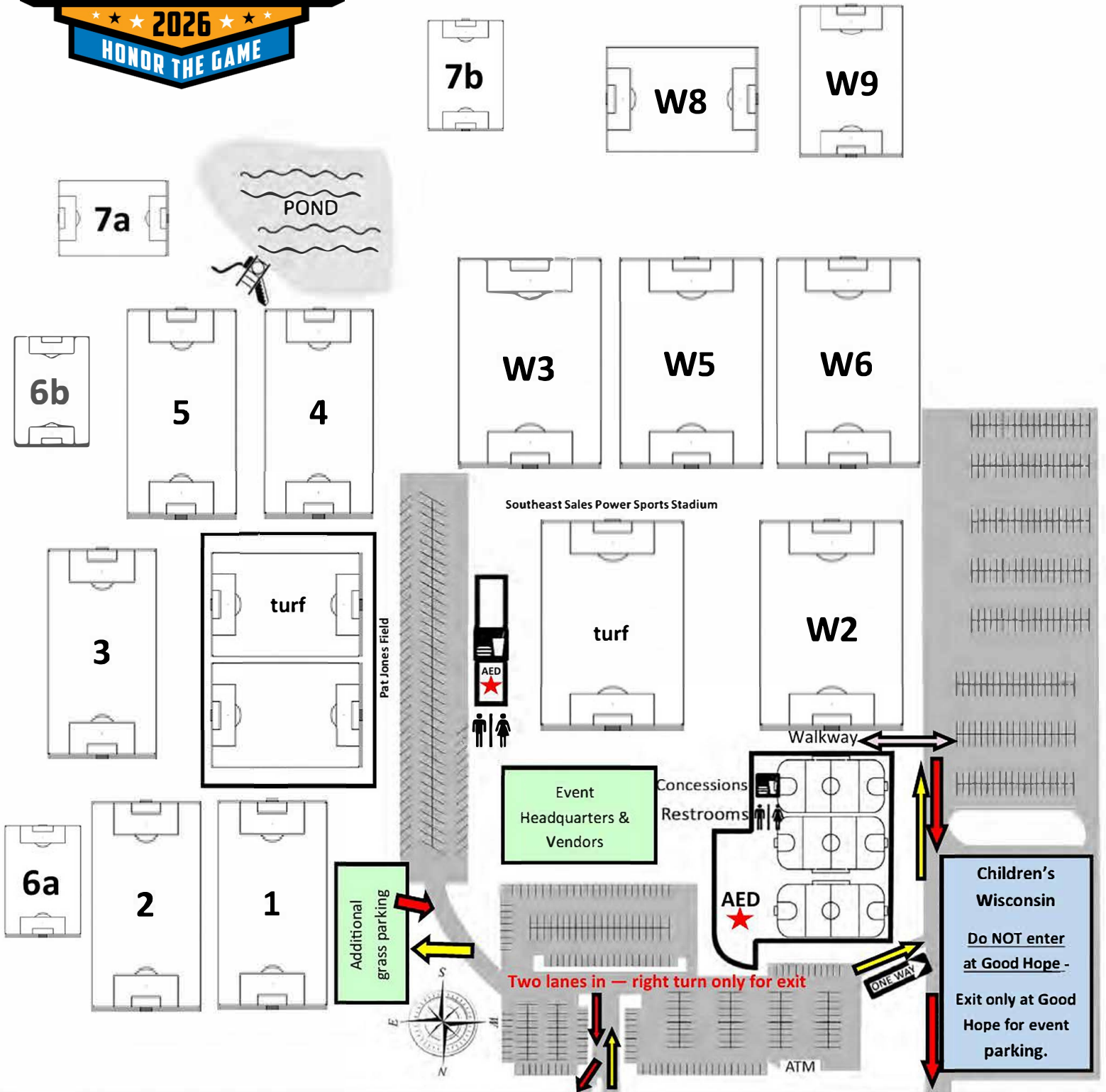

# Team Information

## Games

- Each team in the Boys and Girls Leagues will play 2 games on Saturday and 2 games on Sunday. Little Scoopers will play one day.
- Start time: All games will start on the hour.
- Officials: Grades 3-8: All games will be officiated by certified referees. Lil' Scoopers: No officials, coaches will officiate.
- Two 20-minute halves. Running halves.
- 1 timeout per half. The clock stops upon time outs. Timeouts are one minute. Three-minute halftime.
- 2 OT max, no timeouts, if no winner by end of 2nd OT, coin flip.
- If a player is ejected (for reasons other than too many fouls) they must sit out the next game.
- 
- If weather conditions dictate, the Laxravaganza committee reserves the right to shorten or cancel games, as necessary, without rebate of fees.
- There will not be any bleachers or stadium seating. It is recommended to bring your own chairs.

## Rules

We will follow all regular season rules per NFHS/USA Lacrosse and MAYLA rule exceptions and policies. There will be a copy of MAYLA rules in the field binders located at the scorer's table.

## Team Responsibilities

- **Each team will need to assign a culture keeper for each game**
- Each team will provide 12 game lacrosse balls for their games.
- Designated home team (**first team listed**) needs to provide 2 adult volunteers to manage the scoring table.
- Scoring table volunteers please learn how to use the Lax Clock or your phone's Timer prior to the start of the game!
- ***VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED!*** Please encourage your families to volunteer during the break between games (parking, fastest shot contest, raffle runners, floaters, etc.). Please have all volunteers arranged prior to the weekend, using [SignUpGenius](#).
