Evaluation Rules (For Players)

- Required Attendance: All players in 8U and older divisions must attend evaluations, unless they are frozen by a head coach, assistant coach, or sponsor.
- Frozen Players: Players who are frozen to a team do not need to be evaluated.
- **Non-Attendees:** All registered players will be placed on a team whether or not they attend evaluations. However:
 - Those who do not attend evaluations will be randomly assigned to a team by staff.
 - They will **not be eligible for the draft**.
 - o No exceptions will be made.

Check In Volunteers will:

- Ask for the player's name and age.
- Locate the player on the **Check-In Draft Sheet**.
- Assign a **large numbered sticker** that matches the player's draft number.

- If it appears players are **siblings**, verify this and ensure it's noted on the draft sheet. If not already labeled, make a note.
- **Confirm uniform size** with the parent. If incorrect, clearly note the updated size on the draft sheet.

Waiting Area & Line Formation

Volunteer Assignments in Waiting Area:

Role Description Volunteers Needed
Line Leaders 1 per division (front only) 2 (One for Boys & one for girls)

- Players will line up along the wall on the opposite sides. One for boys and the other for girls.
- Volunteers needed: 1 volunteer per division.
- Responsibilities:
 - o Keep players in line by **ascending number order**.
 - o Maintain order, engage kids calmly, ensure safety.
- Parents stay in bleacher area during evaluations.

Evaluation Court Assignments

- Boys: Left Half Court (Closest to Parking Area)
- Girls: Right Half Court
- Line Leader 1 (front of line):
 - o Announces: "Player #105 Testy McTest"
 - o Waits until coaches are ready before sending each player in.
- Line Leader 2 (end of line):
 - o Ensures kids are safe and in order.
 - Escorts finished players out of the evaluation zone back to parents and exit out the side exit by the parking area.
