

PLAYER REPRESENTATIVE

The Player Representative is to represent the needs and concerns of the league's players (and to some extent families) to ensure that the needs of our players are equally represented when issues arise. The Player Representative plays a key role in the balance of the league. The Player Representative should work to balance the needs of the league (competitive balance, draft rules, etc.). The Player Representative is the key to a healthy balance of fun and competition and critical to Rancho ACE's ability to remain consistent with the aims of USA Softball and our league's mission.

NOTE: The player agent should not manage, coach or umpire to avoid conflict of interest

The responsibilities of the Player Representative include the following:

- Schedules and oversees player clinics.
- Works with division representatives to oversee player evaluation.
- Assists the President in conducting player draft.
- Confirms eligibility of players.
- Supervises and coordinates the transfer of players from one division to the other.
- Handles player complaints regarding coaches and involve the Board of Directors as necessary.
- Assists Vice President of Operations with any player discipline or injury reports.

The Player Representative's point of contact will be the Rancho Cucamonga ACE Softball League President. As such, the Player Representative will be the first point of contact for the following Board Positions:

- All Star Coordinator
- Division Coordinator
