

# **Thunder All-Stars**



### What is the Thunder All-Star Program?

- Class-B All-Star team
- May through July

Thunder provides additional opportunities for RGS players who are looking to experience a more advanced level of play and competition. All-Star teams will participate in local tournaments against other All-Star and Select teams. The goal for the season is to qualify for and attend either the California State Games (8u) or the Western Nationals Tournament (10u-14u).



### Eligibility

We are to here to support families to ensure all players have a fun and rewarding experience.

- Players must tryout for a spot on the team.
- Players may NOT workout, guest play, or participate in activities with any outside teams. Cause for immediate removal.
- Teams may NOT play with, scrimmage against, or participate in workouts with A Ball/Travel teams.



### Role of the Parent

- Support your Player by being positive
- Support your Team by being positive
- Represent Roseville Girls Softball at all events
- Follow the RGS Code of Conduct
- Follow 24 Hour Rule
- No alcohol at any time



### Registration

- Fees: \$500
- Full payment (\$500) or payment plan (1st payment \$300 at registration, 2nd payment \$200 in June )



### What Is Included with Registration

- Fees: \$500
- Includes:
  - Program fees for All-Star Program
  - Uniforms
  - Allocation towards All-Star team discretionary funds (\$75)
  - 4 Tournament Entry Fees
  - League-associated expenses (fields, chalk, equipment, insurance, etc.)
  - Team supplies (first aid kits, etc.)
  - Team equipment (catcher gear, etc.)



### What Is Included With Uniforms?

- 2 game jerseys
- 1 practice jersey
- 1 sweatshirt
- 2 pair of socks
- Helmet decal
- Visor

\* not included: pants, helmet, belt, etc.



## Will There Be Additional Costs/Expenses?

- Additional expenses may include extra tournaments (including Western Nationals or State Games), pants and helmets, batting cages or other training activities, team building activities, travel, etc.
- Expenses may be covered by:
  - Team discretionary funds
  - Fundraising
  - Out of pocket
- Coaches must discuss with parents how discretionary funds and fundraiser monies are to be used.



### **Sponsorships**

Each team is <u>required</u> to secure at least one season sponsor to supplement the cost the league incurs to operate the Thunder Select Program.

#### **Select Sponsorship: \$400**

- Logo on RGS website
- Individual thank you post on social media platforms
- Logo on summer parade banner



### **Fundraising**

Fundraising is allowed and encouraged to help cover additional team expenses, including Western Nationals.

- Approval from RGS Board is required BEFORE fundraising begins
- Appropriate RGS logo and Tax ID must be used
- Team fundraising only (no individual player fundraisers hosted by the team)
- Team Managers must track/report all revenues and expenses
- Must comply with RGS Fundraising and Sponsorship Policy (outlined in RGS Operating Policy)



## What is CA State Games (8u)

- State Games is where the best All-Star teams from all over California and Nevada come together to compete in a 3-day tournament.
- This special event is designed to combine team bonding and team competition and includes not only game-play but team costume contests, massive opening ceremonies and more.
- Teams must qualify for State Games and do so through the Association Tournament.
- Rules are much different for State Games. No coach pitch. Stealing allowed.





## What is Western Nationals (10u & Above)

- Western Nationals is where the best All-Star and Select teams from all over California, Nevada, Oregon, Hawaii, and Washington come together to compete in a weeklong tournament.
- This special event is designed to combine team bonding and team competition and includes not only game-play but team costume contests, pin trading, skills contests and more!
- Teams must qualify for Western Nationals and do so through season tournament play.

July 12 - 13: NorCal All Stars 10U - 14U
