Insurance Requirements

Ongoing user groups are required to submit insurance information to the City Field Scheduler prior to each season. Requirements are:

- Minimum insurance limits, including \$1,000,000 each occurrence and \$2,000,000 general aggregate in US Dollars
- Insurance company must be located and licensed to do business in the USA
- The insured name on the certificate must be identical to the legal entity name listed on the exhibit contract
- Policy number must be entered
- Policy period must cover the dates of the contract
- Name the City of Redmond, including its officers, officials, employees, and volunteers as additional insured
- Additional insured endorsement (Form CG 2026 must be attached to the certificate)

Field Request Deadlines

All field requests must be **received by the published due date** to be considered for that season. Requests can be submitted at any time, but:

- Submitting early does **not** guarantee early processing or special consideration.
- Requests received **after the deadline** will be processed in the order received, based on remaining availability **after** seasonal allocations are completed. Note that requests received after the deadline will be last priority.

On-Going User Groups:

Field Use Categories:

Ongoing Users

- Defined as individuals or groups that reserve fields for multiple months (full season or year-round) or multiple dates, five or more reservations in a season (e.g., league games, sports camps).
- Must coordinate with the City Field Scheduler.

Short-Term / One-Time Users

- Defined as individuals or groups that reserve fields for fewer than five reservations in a season (e.g., tournaments, field days, team practices, company or family events).
- Must submit a [Field Request Form](#), available on the [City Rentals webpage](#).

Allocation Process:

Field scheduling priority is as follows:

1. **City Programs** – City-run leagues, programs, and events
2. **Lake Washington School District**
3. **Ongoing Users**
4. **Short-Term / One-Time Users**

Additional Notes:

- Past use history is considered but does not guarantee future reservations.
- Groups may be asked to submit organization rosters with participant addresses during allocation.
- Within Ongoing Users and Short-Term Users, priority is based on residency and age:
 1. Youth Residents
 2. Adult Residents
 3. Youth Non-Residents
 4. Adult Non-Residents

Field Rental Process (One Time/Short-Term Users)

Step 1: Identify Your Needs

Before submitting a request, determine:

- Field type needed (turf, soccer, baseball, softball, lacrosse, cricket, multi-use).
- Requested dates and times (include set-up and tear-down).
- Type of use (practice, game, tournament, clinic, camp, event).
- Estimated number of participants.
- Organization type (youth, adult, commercial, private).

Step 2: Submit a Field Rental Request

Complete and submit the [Field Rental Application](#)

- Submitting early does **not** guarantee early processing or special consideration.
- Applications will be reviewed and processed after seasonal requests have been allocated.
- Submitting a request does not guarantee approval.
- Additional documentation may be required (insurance, licenses, etc.).

Step 3: City Review & Scheduling

- Requests are reviewed based on field availability, field conditions, priorities, and City policies.
- You will be notified if your request is approved, needs adjustment, or cannot be accommodated within 24-48 hours from the time of your request.

Step 4: Permit Approval & Payment

- Approved requests receive an email with permit and further instructions on how to secure the rental.
- Payment is due upon receiving that email and signing the permit immediately.
- Failure to sign and pay will result in permit cancellation.

Step 5: Arrive Prepared

- Have a copy of the approved permit available.
- Use only the field(s), dates, and times listed on the permit, **no early arrivals and late stays**.

Step 6: Follow Field Use Rules

- Ensure all participants and spectators understand [sport fields rules and regulations](#).
- Using approved equipment only.
- Follow City of Redmond behavior and conduct expectations.
- Report injuries, hazards, or unsafe conditions to City staff.

Step 7: Clean Up the Field

- Remove all trash, equipment, and personal items.
- Return movable goals or equipment if applicable.
- Vacate the field promptly at your permitted end time.
- Allow the next scheduled user to access the field.

Step 8: Report Issues or Feedback

- Report any field damage or concerns to the City to fieldrentals@redmond.gov
- Outstanding issues or damages may impact future rental eligibility.

To protect and preserve the quality of the sports fields and provide a clean and safe environment, the following is prohibited per [Sports Field Regulations](#):

- All food including seeds, nuts, and gum
- Any beverage other than water or sports drinks
- Glass bottles or glass containers of any type
- Smoking or tobacco products of any kind
- Alcoholic beverages
- Dogs or pets
- Fireworks, explosive devices, combustible liquids, and open flames
- Unauthorized marking of lines or boundaries (adhesive tape, paint, or chalk)
- Puncturing turf with sharp objects including metal athletic cleats (rubber only), stakes and flags
- Golfing
- Hitting of Baseballs: Only allowed for ages 12 and under. Ages 10 and under may scrimmage but no official games. Ages 11-12 may only hit in practice format
- Unauthorized installation/storage of goals or sports equipment
- Throwing, batting, or kicking balls against fences
- Motorized vehicles or toys (including remote controlled cars, model aircraft, drones, and rockets)
- Bicycles, scooters, skateboards, and rollerblades
- Unauthorized advertisement banners or signs
- Any selling of goods/services

Cancellation Policy

- **Full Refund:** Written cancellations received **more than 7 days** before the scheduled event are eligible for a full refund, minus any credit card processing fees.
- **No Refund:** Cancellations received **7 days or less** before the event, or any bookings made **within 7 days** of the event, are **non-refundable**.
- **Modifications and Rescheduling:** Any changes to the permit, including switching or rescheduling dates, are subject to the same cancellation rules.
- **Processing Fees:** A \$15.50 processing fee and any applicable credit card fees apply to all modifications or cancellations.

Rainouts/Inclement Weather

During rain, Dirt and Les Dow Field please follow the below protocol:

- Call Rainout Line prior to arrival **425.200.0076**
- Check field status online at www.redmond.gov/fieldstatus
- Download the Rainout Line application for iOS or Android to check field status/sign up for push/text/email alerts
- Umpires/referees and/or coaches must cancel games if rain persists (on dirt & Les Dow fields only)
- Contact City Field Scheduler as soon as possible if requesting a refund due to weather

If there is inclement weather (i.e., snow, lightning, extreme heat—100°F or above) as determined by City of Redmond Parks and Recreation Leadership, we will consider a full refund. User groups do not determine conditions and playability of City of Redmond Fields.

All City of Redmond Turf fields have field lights available for rentals that require lights. **Field lights will not be on if there is no scheduled use on the field.** 2026 field lighting schedule is below. All field lights are controlled remotely through Musco, our online light scheduling program.
