



2025 Sand Volleyball Tournament

RULES

- **Co-Rec Play:** For Co-Rec play, team line-up must abide by the following stipulations:
 - A team may play with a minimum of 4, maximum 6 players.
 - The number of women must be equal to or greater than the number of men.
 - At least one women must be in the front line rotation during the game.
 - When a team has four players, the serving order must alternate by gender.
- **Matches:** Every service, except a replay results in a point.
If the serving team wins the rally, it receives a point and continues to serve.
If the receiving team wins the rally, it receives a point and the ball for service. Will play best of 3 games. First 2 games to 25, last game to 15. Must win by 2
- **Officiating:** There will be one official in Sand Volleyball. Honesty is appreciated by all! The sand volleyball court supervisor has the authority to make rulings and decisions as needed in cases where teams cannot agree.
- **Results:** Team captains are responsible for reporting match results to the sand volleyball Event Coordinator on site. Tournament standings will be kept by the City of Austin Parks and Recreation staff.
- **Boundary Line:** A ball touching the boundary line is considered in bound.
- **Unsportsmanlike Conduct:** Rude behavior and foul language will not be tolerated. Offending individuals will be asked to leave the sand court area. If offending individuals are involved in some way with a particular team (either as a player or spectator), then his/her team may be subject to forfeiture of games.
