



**West Grove Girls Softball League 2026
All-Stars Post-Season Eligibility/Commitment Form**

WHAT: Every year, players from each division are selected, on or after the last Sunday of April, to be members of an All-Star Team representing WGGSL in post-season tournaments. During the All-Star season, the focus changes from growth and development, to competitive play where the primary goal is to win.

WHO: The All-Star Teams will consist of the top twelve (12) players available to play as selected by the managers and coaches of the division. If enough interest persists with talented players, including pitching, a second team may be formed, pending coach and manager availability.

WHEN: The All-Star Team will be selected on or after the last Sunday of April. Players who are selected will be notified on **May 1st**. All teams will be announced during the league Closing Ceremonies. The season will run from approximately May thru August.

EVERY PLAYER in a competitive division needs to complete this form. The completed form must be returned to the Player Agent or your manager in a SEALED envelope, **which will be opened** prior to voting.

By **singing** this eligibility form, you are giving permission for your child to participate in a post-season team **IF** she is selected. This does **not** confirm that your child *will* be selected. It is quite an honor to be selected to participate on an All-Star team, but it requires a commitment from the players and parents. Only players who are in good financial standing with the league will be considered for selection.

****A player may not opt into All-Stars if they are unable to make every practice and game. Only extenuating circumstances (i.e. illness, injury, death in the family) will qualify as a reason to miss a game or practice.**

PARENT EXPECTATIONS

In order to commit to the All-Star Team, each player's parent understands the following conditions:
(initial by each condition)

- ___ 1. I understand that my daughter may **not** play in every game; play time is not guaranteed.
- ___ 2. I further understand that the WGGSL rules regarding the amount of playing time are **not** applicable to post season teams and the All-Star coach and manager have complete authority to determine batting and fielding line ups for tournaments and games.
- ___ 3. I understand that my daughter may not play all positions, which may include her preferred position; positions will be determined by the coach/manager in the best interest of the team.
- ___ 4. I agree to **not** consume alcohol on the premises that any tournament may take place.
- ___ 5. I understand that the Code of Conduct and Ethics that I agreed to as part of the 2026 Spring registration process is still valid and in place during All-Stars.
- ___ 6. I will support all the players and their coaches throughout the season.
- ___ 7. I understand that my daughter may only miss practices and/or games due to extenuating circumstances (i.e.

illness, injury, death in the family).

- ____ 8. I understand that missing a tournament, not due to extenuating circumstances, can jeopardize my daughter's All-Star eligibility for the following year.
- ____ 9. I will ensure that my daughter attends ALL scheduled practices.
- ____ 10. I will ensure that my daughter attends EVERY scheduled game.
- ____ 11. I agree that my daughter will play for the team to which she is selected.
- ____ 12. I understand that the standard tournament season is from May to June, but could go through July or August.
- ____ 13. I understand that practices may be more frequent than during the regular season.
- ____ 14. I agree to represent WGGSL in an appropriate manner at all times.
- ____ 15. I understand that teams will be participating in tournaments at our own facility as well as others that may require overnight travel.

PLAYER EXPECTATIONS

1. I understand that I may not play in every game or every inning.
2. I understand that I may not play all positions or my preferred position(s).
3. I will play to the best of my ability while an active member of the All-Star Team.
4. I will be at ALL scheduled practices and make good use of the time.
5. I will be at EVERY scheduled game.
6. I understand that I may be pulled mid-inning if the coach/manager deems it necessary.
7. I understand that the tournament season is from May to June, but could go through July or August.
8. I agree to play for the team to which I am selected.

FINANCIAL COMMITMENT

There is a mandatory up-front fee (\$600 - \$650) DUE and PAYABLE to WGGSL by **May 2, 2026** for every girl rostered on a team. The final amount will be determined and communicated prior to payment being due. This amount represents approximately 70% of the total cost, with the remaining portion subsidized by the league. Approximate breakdown of the fee is attached.

In addition to the above fee, coaches may select, at the team's expense, to add additional tournaments. All travel and lodging expenses for any tournament are the responsibility of the player. Teams may also solicit sponsorships or participate in fundraisers to generate additional funds for team expenses.

There will be a MANDATORY ALL-STAR PARENT MEETING on May 2nd, after the league Closing Ceremonies. One parent or guardian of each player will be required to attend this meeting. Payment in full as determined above will be required, as well as mandatory uniform fittings.

ADDITIONAL TEAMS

Per USA Softball rules, any player who has participated (taking part in a try-out, practice, practice game, a scheduled game or tournament) on a team other than their own recreation league team after March 31st is not eligible to participate on a recreational All-Star team in any USA Softball sanctioned event.

ALL-STAR GOAL

The goal of All-Stars is to represent WGGSL in post-season play. This is competitive play and winning is the primary goal. Playing time and positions are not guaranteed. Coaches are not required to play players a minimum number of innings. While some players may prefer one position to another, it is important to recognize that at this competitive level of play, all positions are critical to the team's success, and the coach will assign them accordingly.
