



BASKETBALL TIME OUT

NEW FORMAT

Fall Basketball will consist of a single round robin season.

RULES & EQUIPMENT

Managers are expected to relay all program and rule information to their teammates.

Personal fouls: In a continuing effort to eliminate excessive contact, the following acts constitute a personal foul when committed against a ball handler/dribbler.

- Placing two hands on the player
- Placing an extended arm bar on the player
- Placing and keeping a hand on the player
- Contacting the player with the same or alternate hands

A player becomes a ball handler when they receive the ball. This includes a player in the post position.

SUBSTITUTE PLAYERS

There is no fee for substitute players. Should a team be short a player, a player from another team is allowed to sub on your team to avoid a forfeit.

To add a substitute player to your team:

- No player waiver is needed if the player is already a rostered player on another team
- If the player is not a rostered player with another team, they should complete the "Substitute Player Agreement" card and submit it with the score sheet at the end of the game. Substitute Player Agreement cards may be obtained from the Site Supervisor.

Substitute players can be added once the full roster has been submitted.

FORFEITS / PHONE AHEAD

No one likes showing up to a game just to learn the opponent is not there. If you know ahead of time that your team will forfeit, notify MSCR at asld@madison.k12.wi.us or 608-204-3024 prior to 4:45 pm on the day of play. After 4:45 pm, contact MSCR at 608-204-3029.

KEEP YOUR COOL

- If your team forfeits twice they may be removed from the program?
- If they are ejected from a game they must also sit out for the next two games?
