Recreational: Coach Pitch, 10U, 12U, 14U, High School

Age Classification: ALL Competitive & Recreational rosters will be based on the **9/1/2026** age date for USSSA.

Rules: USSSA Rules will be used, with Fall Ball exceptions posted at IPGSA.com (All ages & divisions)

High School Divisions: Due to overwhelming interest and success, the HS Division is back.

- Players are encouraged to play for their High School programs first
- Teams may enter as a full team or players may register individually
- Separate Competitive and Recreational divisions offered when numbers allow

If participation numbers are too low, divisions may be combined.

- Individual players may register for Fall Ball (see IPGSA.com for forms).
- Registration covers **100% of Fall Ball costs**, including practice fields, equipment, uniforms, insurance, game fields, umpires, and the End-of-Season Tournament.
- Players eligible for 14U in 2027 may play either 14U or High School Division. High School players must obtain Principal approval per CHSAA rules and provide a copy to their Fall Ball Coach.
- Players may try out for Competitive teams, but placement is not guaranteed.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Team fees must be received by **September 1, 2026**.
- Proof of insurance is required (or may be purchased for **\$139**).
- High School players eligible for 14U in 2027 may play either 14U or High School Division. CHSAA approval is required for players participating on High School teams.
- Teams should register in the division that best matches their level of play. The Fall Ball Board reserves the right to reclassify teams during the first two weeks of play if necessary.

Cost Breakdown: (The cost breakdown below uses the highest team fee of \$1,245. Actual costs for 12U teams are lower.)

Based on a \$1,245 team fee and a 12-player roster:

- Approximately \$88.90 per game OR approximately \$7.41 per player, per game

As teams advance in the End-of-Season Tournament, the cost per game decreases. Examples:

- 16 games = approximately \$77.81 per game or \$6.48 per player, per game
- 20 games = approximately \$62.25 per game or \$5.19 per player, per game

10U COMPETITIVE

- No Seeding Day.
- For experienced teams planning to play 10U Competitive Softball in 2027.
- Uses the 11-inch softball.

12U COMPETITIVE (A, B & C)

- Unlimited tournaments and practices allowed.
- Strong 12U B teams may request placement in 14U (subject to review)

14U COMPETITIVE (A, B & C)

- For experienced teams planning to play Competitive Softball in 2027.
 - Unlimited tournaments and practices allowed.
 - High School players may participate.
 - Strong 14U B teams may request higher-level placement (subject to review).

Cost Breakdown: (The cost breakdown below uses the 14U Rec fee of \$955. Fees for 8U-12U are lower, while High School fees are higher due to two-umpire games.)

- Approximately \$79.58 per game and \$6.63 per player, per game

As teams advance in the End-of-Season Tournament, the cost per game decreases. Examples:

- 15 games = approximately \$63.67 per game or \$5.30 per player, per game
 - 18 games = approximately \$53.06 per game or \$4.42 per player, per game

COACH-PITCH DIVISION (8U)

- For players planning to play 8U Recreational Softball in 2027.
 - Uses a 10-inch softball.
 - Must not turn 9 before 9/1/2026.

10U RECREATIONAL (30-Foot Pitching Distance with an Arc)

- For players planning to play 10U Recreational Softball in 2027.
 - Uses an 11-inch softball.
 - Must not turn 11 before 9/1/2026.

12U RECREATIONAL (37-Foot Pitching Distance)

- For players planning to play 12U Recreational Softball in 2027.
 - Must not turn 13 before 9/1/2026.

14U RECREATIONAL (43-Foot Pitching Distance)

- For players planning to play 14U Recreational Softball in 2027.
- Must not turn 15 before 9/1/2026.
- High School players may participate.

HIGH SCHOOL RECREATIONAL

- Ages 15-18.
- Must not turn 19 before 9/1/2026.
- Fees: See 14U Competitive Cost Breakdown.
- May be combined with HS Competitive divisions if numbers are low.
