*MOST Gates open 60 minutes before first games

*Please check if Dogs are allowed. Most complexes DO NOT allow for dogs. If you are at a complex that does allow dogs, aggressive and/or continuously barking dogs will be asked to leave

*Please have your parents and players clean the stands and dug-outs after each game. Thanks!

*If the fields have fences, teams are welcome to warm-up behind them. Please do not enter the field during live play

*Smoking/Vaping/Chewing/Drinking are not allowed at any of the complexes. Please remind your fans... young lungs at work!

Rules for Comp EOS

Rules: All age groups please follow ([USSSA Fastpitch Playing Rules](#)) with the following exceptions:

(If we DO NOT list a rule/change and/or adaptation, please refer to USSSA rules for clarification)

~HIGHER SEED THROUGH WINNER'S Bracket. COIN-TOSS for all games in the LOSER'S Bracket

~Game Time: 75 minutes (we DO NOT use no new inning after 70, that is a Fall Ball rule only)

~Must have a winner. Can't end in a tie. In the case of a tie, the ITB will be used

~Games are NOT Drop Dead. Games will be played with Fair ups and finish the inning (if needed)

~Will play 10/8/6 after 3/4/5 for all age divisions all days of the tourney

~Free defensive substitution at all positions

~Run limit per inning: 10u, 12u & 14u (6 runs), HS (no limit)

~Must bat the entire line-up (If a team does not BAT ALL, the game will be forfeited. If a player is injured or not playing, please let the ump and opposing team know BEFORE the game starts)

~Courtesy runners may be used for the Pitcher/Catcher. Last completed at bat

~For EOS Tourney Only, Pick-up Players may be used, but Can NOT pitch

~No automatic out (For less than 9 players and/or injuries). If a player is ejected, she will be an out each time in the lineup

~Please stay off dirt infield for warm-ups. Most Complexes open 60 minutes before 1st game
