CBPA Program Details

Indoor workouts at the Broomfield location starting December 2nd and ending the week of February 20th. There are two workouts per week for CBPA Tournament teams. RMJBL League teams will begin The Week of March 2nd and conclude the Week of April 10th. The players will train with CBPA instructors who either played professional or collegiate baseball. Legacy High School Varsity Head Coach Ty Giordano will coordinate all disciplines of training with the help of the V-Tool (Tom Dedin, Lucas Gilbreath & Shawn Kirkman) and other college or professional coaches.

TRAINING SESSIONS ARE 120 MINUTE BLOCKS

Pre-season training December 2025 and **In-season** training starts January 5th. Teams will train for 2 hours:

MONDAY/WEDNESDAY - 5:30 - 10:00PM or TUESDAY/THURSDAY - 5:30 - 10:00PM

6-20 Indoor Training Sessions of professional level training.

No instructor training the weeks of December 21st-25th, and December 28th-January 1st. However, the facility will be available for use for teams and individuals CBPA members.

Team Practices and Outdoor Practices: Instructors will participate in some outdoor practices to ensure continuity of our program

- **CBPA Fast Pitch Program** Teams can plan on playing in 8-12 tournaments per year in and out of state, as well as playing in the IPGSA leagues. Costs are in addition and will be determined by the team
 - Tournaments will be played all over the Front Range area based on tournament locations (USSSA, Triple Crown, CABA, and others).
 - Individual teams will decide which tournaments to play in with the help of CBPA based on appropriate level, Our SGK Bats 4 a Cure tournament is a required tournament for all CBPA Teams (New this year)

CBPA Fast Pitch Program

All teams will receive professional training conducted by our training staff and Vtool elite performance. Teams will begin training the week of November 30th running through March 10th.

\$1475/Player includes up to 12 (1X per Week during winter training) sessions with our professional trainers.

Teams and players will attend sports performance training through the season, as well as have indoor and outdoor baseball skills training with the training staff. Coaches will also attend preseason and in season coaches training. Teams should plan on up to 15 tournaments in the spring including travel tournaments. Uniform costs and tournaments are separate fees paid directly to team managers. Head coaches will receive a 20% discount for their players. Assistant coaches will receive up to a 10% discount on player registration (limit 2 assistant coaches).

Tournament, IPGSA league and Uniform fees are in addition to the league costs.
